- 2. Honestly answer the big question, "What legacy do I want to leave for my family?" Now, share it with your family.
- 3. Commit to memory 1 Corinthians 11:1 (NIV), "Follow my example, as I follow the example of Christ." Share it aloud with your family and encourage them to memorize it as well.
- 4. Praise God, our Faithful Father, for the opportunity to model your own fatherhood after His perfect example. Now, pray this prayer with your family.*
- 5. If there is a need, pray now that God would soften your heart towards your dad.*

If you have/had a good relationship with your dad, simply thank God for this amazing blessing, and then ask God to please heal those families who don't have such a relationship.*

6. If there is a need, forgive your dad, remembering God forgives us.*

ΛR

If there is/was a spirit of forgiveness between you and your dad simply praise God for this blessing.*

- 7. If a need exists, reconcile with your father if possible, remembering God has reconciled with His children. OR
 - If you and your father have already reconciled, ask God to help others fathers and sons reconcile.
- 8. <u>If possible</u>, contact your dad in whatever method you feel most comfortable with (written letter, phone call, text, meet for breakfast, etc.) and thank him.

OF

If not possible, write a thank you letter to your dad and share it with your family.

- 9. Consider: What change(s) do you need to make to better live for God? Start today!
- 10. Consider: What change(s) do you need to make to better live for others, especially your family? Start today!
- 11. How does Jesus' supreme example of living for God and living for others impact your view of your own lasting legacy?
- 12. What vulnerable act of service is God calling you to perform? Now, serve outside your comfort zone.
